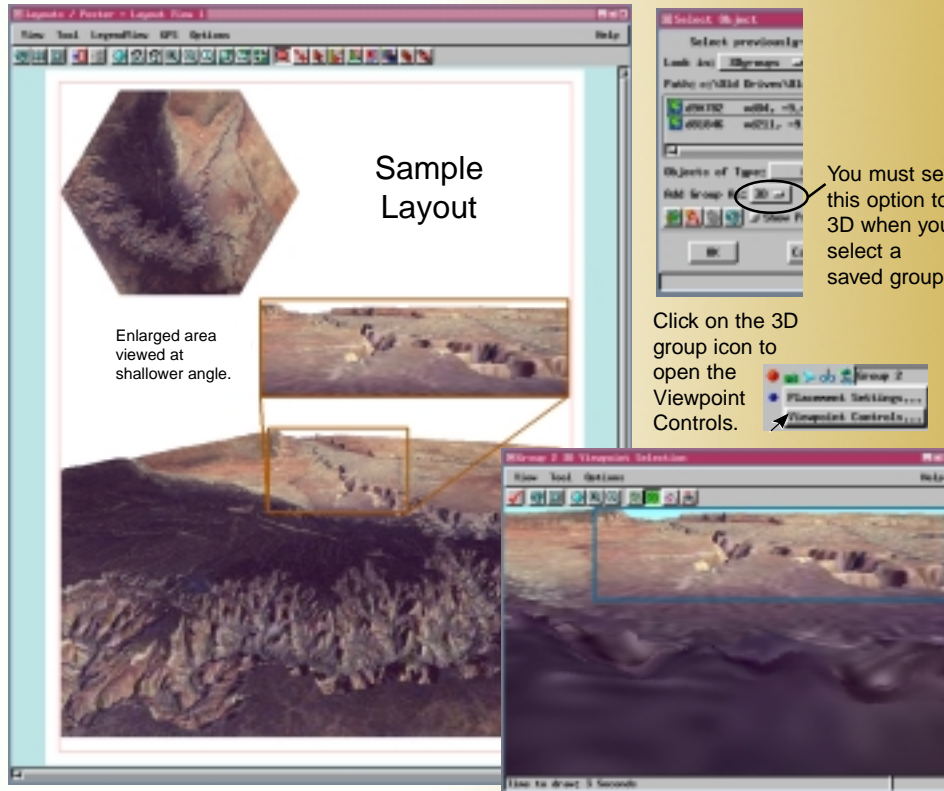


Incorporate 3D in Your Posters

DID YOU KNOW . . . you can add a 3D group to any layout?

What Adding 3D to Posters Gives You

- Add visual stimulus to your posters
- Show the same area from a variety of angles and elevations
- Familiarize viewer with area's topography



How to Add 3D Groups to Your Poster Layouts

- Choose *Group/Add/From Saved Object* (set the Add Group As button to 3D in the Select Object window).
- Open the Viewpoint Controls for the 3D group and adjust if necessary.
- Click and hold the left mouse button to draw a box in the Viewpoint Selection window around the area you want shown in the layout, then click on the Apply Changes icon.
- In layout display mode, you can also add a new 3D group, select the surface and drape layers, set the Viewpoint Controls, and select the desired area.
